Sheldon Tallies 10th Victory; Krebs Takes 15th Women's Crown

ROXBURY – Jeff Sheldon, 32, of Southbury and Theresa Krebs, 43, of Roxbury both added to their season victory totals Saturday, July 14, at the Roxbury Road Race Series, prevailing over a challenging 5.1-mile course.

Sheldon was the overall winner for the 10th time this season, finishing in 31-minutes, 3-seconds on the layout, which included a trip up the long inclines on Ranney Hill and Hemlock roads.

Tyler Mannion, 16, placed second in 31:31.

Krebs captured her 15th win in the women's division and took 13th overall in 35:47.

The series will resume Saturday, July 21, at 8:30 a.m. with the Bill Burley MidSummer Championship over a 5.0-mile course that travels up the steep hills on Squire Road.

There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20. Proceeds will help pay for cones for the Roxbury Marathon and Half Marathon.

The top overall male and female finisher will receive a \$10 gift certificate to the Woodbridge Running Co., which has a store in Brookfield.

The five new inductees to the Roxbury Road Race Series Hall of Fame will be announced during an awards ceremony following the race.

There will be no race Saturday, July 28, since the 45th annual New Milford 7.8-mile run will be held that day.

The series will return Saturday, Aug. 4, with a 6.2-mile race.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park on West Apple Lane.
