## Sheldon, Krebs Prevail In Roxbury Road Race Series Season Opener

ROXBURY – Jeff Sheldon and Theresa Krebs, who posted a daily double several times during the 2012 Roxbury Road Race Series, did it again in the 2013 season opener as they captured their respective men's and women's titles in a field of 80 finishers.

Sheldon, 32, of Southbury easily annexed the overall honors with a clocking of 13-minutes, 57-seconds Saturday, Feb. 23, over the rolling 2.4-mile layout, which included a trip up the steep hill on Chalybes Road.

Stosh Davis, 15, a member of New Milford High School's State Open championship cross country team, was second in 14:32.

Krebs, 43, of Roxbury took the female honors and was 14<sup>th</sup> overall with a time of 16:52.

Some of the runners commented on the impressive turnout of 81 runners overall, counting the alternate race, for the first event in the series' 37<sup>th</sup> season.

Bill Burley, a former Roxbury resident who served as an elementary school principal in New Milford for many years, started the races as an eight-week summer series in 1977.

The series will resume Saturday, Mar. 2, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.1-mile run that will go to the bottom of Hemlock Road and back. There will be no entry fee.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park on Apple Lane.
