Dennen, Masopust Race To Roxbury Triumphs

ROXBURY – Pat Dennen easily captured the men's laurels and Alison Masopust prevailed in the women's division Saturday, Aug. 23, in a 3.7-mile run at the Roxbury Road Race Series.

Dennen, 33, sped through the layout in 21-minutes, 23-seconds – a 5:47-permile pace.

Ryan Ripp, 27, placed second in 23:18.

Masopust was sixth overall with a clocking of 25:20 for the loop, which included a trip down the incline along Ranney Hill Road and up the steep hill on Chalybes Road.

The series will resume Saturday, Aug. 30, at 8:30 a.m. with this year's second edition of the Roxbury Mile, which will go from near the end of Apple Lane, just below the Everett Hurlburt Community Park, to the end of the parking lot at the Booth Free School on South Street. There will be no entry fee.

The seventh annual Two For The Show 3.1-mile event will be held Saturday, Sept. 6, at 8:30 a.m. There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20. Proceeds will be used for research regarding autism and juvenile diabetes. The top overall male and top overall female finisher will each receive a \$10 gift certificate to an area running store.

The weekly races are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission.
