ROXBURY – Ken Merrick and Theresa Krebs, the 2013 season champions, annexed victories June 7, at the Roxbury Road Race Series over a 4.2-mile loop.

He covered the course, which included a trip up the steep incline on Ranney Hill Road, in 25-minutes, 29-seconds for his eighth win of the season.

Jacob Mayerson, 19, finished second in 26:12.

Krebs captured the female division and placed sixth overall with a clocking of 29:22.

The series will resume Saturday, June 14, at 8:30 a.m. with a 6.6-mile run that will include a trip along Sentry Hill Road. There will be no entry fee.

The 5.0-mile Bill Burley MidSummer Championship will be held Saturday, July 19, at 8:30 a.m.

There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20 a.m. Proceeds will go to the Roxbury park improvement fund. The top overall male and top overall female will each receive a \$10 gift certificate to an area running store.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
