<u>Sheldon, Gallagher Annex Fourth Wins of 2015</u> <u>At Roxbury</u>

ROXBURY – Jeff Sheldon and Theresa Gallagher each garnered their fourth victories of the season at the Roxbury Road Race Series Saturday, August 1, as they took their respective divisions over a challenging 6.2-mile route.

Sheldon, 34, of Southbury was timed in 37-minutes, 15-seconds – a 6:00-permile pace – over the loop, which included a jaunt up the series of hills along Painter Ridge Road.

That earned him first place overall, with Cole Rossiter, 22, a former New Milford High School harrier, placing second in 37:15.

Gallagher, 46, of Roxbury was the first female finisher and took seventh overall in 48:45.

The weekly series will continue Saturday, August 8, at 8:30 a.m. with an 8.2-mile run that will include a trip up and down part of Judd's Bridge Road. There will be no entry fee.

The eighth annual Two For The Show Race will be run over a 3.1-mile course Saturday, September 12, at 8:30 a.m.

There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20. Proceeds will go toward research into autism and into juvenile diabetes.

The top overall male and top overall female finisher will each receive a \$10 gift certificate to an area running store.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
