Sheldon, 34, of Southbury was clocked in 49-minutes, 7-seconds – a5:59-permile pace – over the loop, which included a trip along parts of Judd's Bridge Road.

Masopust, 31, of Morris was fourth overall in 57:02.

The weekly series will resume Saturday, August 15, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.7-mile run that will include a trip down the long incline along Ranney Hill Road. There will be no entry fee.

The eighth annual Two For The Show race will be held Saturday, September 12, at 8:30 a.m. over a 3.1-mile course

There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20 a.m. Proceeds will go toward research into autism and into juvenile diabetes.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
