Burley Midsummer Run Slated For July 16

ROXBURY – The Bill Burley MidSummer Championship will be run Saturday, July 16, at 8:30 a.m. over a 5.0-mile loop as part of the Roxbury Road Race Series.

The race is named after the founder and first head director of the weekly series. There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20. Proceeds will go to the Roxbury park improvement fund.

The 5.0-mile course will include a trip up the steep hills on Squire Road.

Dr. Burley, a former Roxbury resident and former elementary school principal in New Milford, started the series July 2, 1977 as eight races on Saturdays through July and August. The current 40-race schedule from mid-February to early-December began in the mid-1980's.

The concept came from a similar series in Westport, where he had been a participant.

He served as head director of the Roxbury series through 1979 and was inducted into the Roxbury Road Race Series Hall of Fame in 2007.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
