<u>Creedon, Masopust Stride To 10K Wins At</u> <u>Roxbury</u>

ROXBURY – Tim Creedon, who once ran for Tufts University, was the overall winner and Allison Masopust captured her 15th women's title of the season at the Roxbury Road Race Series Saturday, August 6, over a 6.2-mile (10-kilometer) route that included a trip up the inclines along Painter Hill Road.

Creedon, 33, of Belmont, Mass. posted his fourth win in the weekly series this season, covering the layout in 40-minutes, 09-seconds – a 6:29-per-mile pace.

Jeff Sheldon, 36, of Southbury placed second in 40:50. He was the season champion in the weekly series in 2005 and 2010.

Masopust, 32, of Morris was eighth overall in 45:26.

The series will resume Saturday, August 13, at 8:30 a.m. with the ninth annual Two For The Show race over a 3.1-mile loop that will travel to the end of Hemlock Road and back.

There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20. Proceeds will go toward research into juvenile diabetes and into autism.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
