<u>Eighth Annual Roxbury Land Trust Run To</u> <u>Travel Along River Road</u>

ROXBURY – Runners will stride through dirt and pavement and then finish their jaunt by circling the perimeter of a preserve at the 3.0-mile Roxbury Land Trust Run.

The eighth annual event is slated for Saturday, September 17, at 8:30 a.m. at the land trust's River Road preserve, and will raise money for its programs. There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20 at the site.

The runners will start on River Road, just outside the preserve and then turn around near where River Road intersects with South Street and return to the preserve.

The run is co-sponsored by the Roxbury Road Race Series, which holds about 40 races annually, starting on the third Saturday of February and concluding on the first Saturday of December.
