

Ninth Annual Race To Raise Money for Juvenile Diabetes, Autism Research

ROXBURY – The Roxbury Road Race Series will hold its ninth annual Two For The Show 3.1-mile run Saturday, August 13, at 8:30 a.m. to benefit research into juvenile diabetes and into autism.

The \$5 entry fee can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20 at the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane, near where the race will start and finish.

The run will travel along a rolling route that will include a trip up and down the long hill on Hemlock Road.

Last year, Ken Merrick of New Fairfield, the four-time defending season champion at the series, and Mary Mahrer, who has a weekend home in Roxbury and is former women's season champion in the series, were the respective overall and female winners at the Two For The Show.

It is one of the 40 events run in the weekly Roxbury Road Race Series, which starts during the third Saturday of February and concludes in early December.
