<u>Sheldon, Masopust Take Titles At Roxbury 5-</u> miler

ROXBURY – Jeff Sheldon copped his second straight win and Alison Masopust posted her 23rd victory of the season over a rolling, 5.0-mile course at the Roxbury Road Race Series.

Sheldon, 36, of Southbury was timed in 30-minutes, 33-seconds – a 6:07-permile pace – Saturday, October 29, over the loop, which included a trip up the long hill on Apple Lane and down the series of inclines on Squire Road. Sheldon captured the season title in the weekly series in 2005 and 2010.

Ken Merrick, 47, of New Fairfield placed second in 32:18. He has taken the season title the last four years in the Roxbury series and is leading the point standings again this year.

Masopust, 32, of Morris was third overall with a clocking of 33:29.

The series will resume Saturday, November 5, with the Mike Abraham MidAutumn Championship over a 3.9-mile course at 8:30 a.m. There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20. Proceeds will go to the series' activities. The race is named after a Roxbury resident who was an assistant director for the races, won a season championship and the Roxbury Marathon.

The Roxbury Half Marathon is slated for Saturday November 12, at 8:30 a.m. Registration is available through the appropriate link at www.roxburyraces.net.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
