

## **Parker, Masopust Master Mallory Road Hills To Win Roxbury 7.25-miler**

**ROXBURY – Sean Parker and Alison Masopust wore the championship fedoras after running a challenging 7.25-mile route with steep uphill sections and then a long downhill flight.**

**Parker, 18, of Roxbury was timed in 45-minutes, 56-seconds – a 6:20-per-mile pace on the course, which went up Mallory Road and down Flag Swamp Road.**

**Joey Nihill, 14, placed second with a time of 49:18 in the Roxbury Road Runners Club series event.**

**Masopust, 33, of Morris annexed the female title and was eighth overall Saturday, July 15, in 53:50.**

**The series will continue on Saturday, July 22, at 8:30 a.m. with a 4.2-mile jaunt that will include a trip down the steep incline along Ranney Hill Road and up the long hill on Hemlock Road.**

**Runners can enter through the \$50 season membership or the \$5 weekly waiver.**

**There will be no race on Saturday, July 29, the day of the 50<sup>th</sup> annual New Milford Village Fair Days 7.8-miler and 3.1-miler.**

**The series will resume on Saturday, August 5, at 8:30 a.m.**

**The 10<sup>th</sup> annual run to benefit research into autism and juvenile diabetes will be held over a 3.1-mile loop on Saturday, August 12, at 8:30 a.m.**

**The \$5 entry fee can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20.**

**The races in the weekly series, which is sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.**
