The Bill Burley MidSummer Championship is slated for Saturday, July 8, at 8:30 a.m. at the Minor Memorial Library on South Street. The runners will cover a 4.4-mile loop. There will be a \$5 entry fee to raise money for the library.

Burley is expected to attend the event, which is named after him for his efforts to establish the series in 1977 and serve for three years as its director.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, usually start and finish near the community park at 18 Apple Lane.
