## <u>Deming, Degirolamo Post Victories In Roxbury</u> 3.52-mile Jaunt

ROXBURY – Chris Deming, a former season champion, and Cynthia Degirolamo, who has captured the women's season title each of the last three years, wore the championship crowns following a 3.52-mile race that included a rolling terrain accentuated by a trip up the long hill on Hemlock Road.

Deming, 50, of Danbury was clocked in 24-minutes, 17-seconds – a 6:54-per-mile pace over the loop.

Nolan Legere, 23, of Brookfield placed second in 25:45.

Degirolamo, 50, of Newtown took eighth overall in 28:01.

The series will resume on Saturday, October 14, at 8:30 a.m. with a 5.0-mile run that will include a trip up the steep hill on Squire Road.

Runners can enter through the \$50 season membership or the \$5 weekly waiver.

The 32<sup>nd</sup> annual MidAutumn Championship will be held on Saturday, November 4, at 8:30 a.m. over a 3.9-mile route that will include a jeep trail.

There will be a \$5 entry fee that can be paid that morning from 7 to 8:20. Proceeds will go to the series' annual T-shirt/grants campaign.
