

Race Canceled Due To Flash Flooding, Five-kilometer Scheduled For August 11

ROXBURY – The scheduled 8.2-mile run on Saturday, August 4, at the Roxbury Road Races Club series was canceled because of flash flooding.

The weekly series will resume on Saturday, August 11, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.1-mile run that will go up and down the long hill on Hemlock Road.

Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership or the \$2 weekly waiver. Youth runners can participate for free by signing the weekly waiver.

The second annual Roxbury Thanksgiving Charity Race over the same 3.1-mile route will be held on Thursday, November 22, at 9 a.m. Runners can enter through the Ultra-Sign-Up link at www.roxburyraces.net.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
