

# **Masopust Romps To Course Record, Deming Takes Second Place In Roxbury Jeep Trail Run**

**ROXBURY – Alison Masopust delivered a performance worthy of a wreath of mini red and white carnations as she posted a course record of 23-minutes, 52-seconds, a 6:38-per-mile pace - on a 3.6-mile loop that included pavement, dirt roads and a jeep trail with stumps, sand, roots and rocks.**

**It was the 13<sup>th</sup> time that she was the first female finisher during the 2019 season at the Roxbury Road Races Club series and the third time she took first place overall.**

**Masopust, 35, of Morris has captured the women's season title at the weekly series the last two years.**

**Chris Deming, 52, of Danbury, a former season champion in the series, placed second overall in the Saturday, August 3, event with a time of 24:12.**

**The series will resume on Saturday, August 10, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.52-mile jaunt that will include a trip up the long hill on Hemlock Road.**

**Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership or the \$2 weekly waiver. Youth runners can participate for free by completing the youth waiver.**

**Registration for the Roxbury Marathon/Half Marathon, slated for Saturday, November 9, at 8:30 a.m. and the Roxbury Thanksgiving Charity Race, scheduled for Thursday, November 28, at 9 a.m. are available through Ultra-Sign-up at [www.roxburyraces.net](http://www.roxburyraces.net).**

**The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, usually start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.**
