

# **Kane, Burns Fastest Harriers Over 3.52-mile Roxbury Loop**

**ROXBURY – James Kane posted his second consecutive triumph and Katie Burns prevailed in the women's division in a 3.52-mile event at the Roxbury Road Races Club series.**

**Kane, 20, was clocked in 21-minutes, 4-seconds – a 5:59-per-mile pace – on Saturday, June 8, over the route, which included a trip up the long hill on Hemlock Road.**

**Burns, 24, placed 14<sup>th</sup> overall with a time of 27:48.**

**The weekly series will resume on Saturday, June 15, at 8:30 a.m. with a 3.0-mile run that will include a trip through part of the Roxbury Land Trust's preserve on River Road.**

**Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership or the \$2 weekly waiver. Youth runners can enter for free by completing the weekly waiver form.**

**The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, usually start and finish near the Everett Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.**

**However, the 34<sup>th</sup> annual Bill Burley MidSummer Championship will be held at the Roxbury Land Trust's preserve on River Road on Saturday, July 13, at 8:30 a.m.**

**The race is named after the founder of the series, who also served as the race director from 1977-1979. Burley, a former Roxbury resident, worked as an elementary school principal in New Milford for many years. He had previously been a physical education teacher in Westport.**
