Andrejczyk Wins Race Of The Sentry

ROXBURY -- Mark Andrejczyk, 48, who has competed in the Roxbury Road Runners Club series for many years, posted his second victory of 2021 by easily outpacing a strong field over a 6.6-mile route.

Andrejczyk was victorious on Saturday, August 28, over the Sentry Road turn-around loop with a time of 47-minutes, 15-seconds – 7:10-per-mile pace over the rolling loop.

He also captured a 5.0-mile run on June 26.

Kateri Danay, 23, who has run in the series since she was in middle school, was the first female finisher, taking fourth overall, with a clocking of 52:52.

The weekly series will resume on Saturday, September 4, at 8:30 a.m. with the Roxbury Mile II, which will be run over two loops at the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.

Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership.

They also can participate by completing the weekly waiver form. If they have a timing chip, the cost is \$2, and if they need to purchase a timing chip, the fee is \$5. Youth runners can complete for free after completing the weekly waiver form.
