Fitzpatrick, Danay Sprint To Victory In Roxbury Mile II

ROXBURY -- Mason Fitzpatrick, 21, and Kateri Danay, 23, were in the winner's circle following the Roxbury Mile II.

Fitzpatrick of Southbury won the event in 5-minutes, 23-seconds over the two loops that covered part of the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park and parts of Rocky Mountain Road and Apple Lane.

Danay, who has competed at the weekly Roxbury Road Runners Club series since she was in middle school, was the first female finisher and placed eighth out of an overall field of 50 runners. She was clocked in 6:24.

The Roxbury Mile I was run on Saturday, May 22.

The series will resume on Saturday, September 11, at 8:30 a.m. with a 6.2-mile run that will include a trip up the long hills on Painter Road.

Runners should pre-register before Friday, September 10, at www.roxburyraces.net.

They can enter via the \$25 season membership. They also can compete by completing the weekly waiver form. If they already have a timing chip, the fee is \$2. If they need a timing chip, the cost is \$5. Youth runners can enter for free after completing the weekly waiver form.

The race will start and finish near the community park. The races are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission.
