The Green Wave's Andrew Taborsak, 17, Ben Daniels, 15, and Collin Walsh 16, were timed in 18-mintes, 44-seconds – a 6:02-per-mile pace - on Saturday, March 26, over the route, which included a trip up and down the long hill on Hemlock Road.

Masopust,. 38, of Morris was the first female finisher, taking 13th overall in 22:34. She has captured multiple season championships in the weekly series.

The series will continue on Saturday, April 2, at 8:30 a.m. with a 4.3-mile race that will include a trip up the hill on High Bridge Road.

Runners can enter through the \$25 season membership or by completing the weekly waiver form. If a runner already has a timing chip, the cost is \$2. If they require a timing chip, the fee is \$2. Youth runners can participate for free after completing the weekly waiver form.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.
