Levy Wins Season Finale At Roxbury Race Series

ROXBURY – Alana Levy - a native of Chappaqua, N.Y. who began running the Roxbury Road Runners Club events about 20 years ago as a middle schooler – easily captured a 3.52-mile jaunt that included a trip down the long hill on Hemlock Road.

Levy, 33, was timed in the Saturday, November 26, race in 21-minutes, 56-seconds – a 6:14-per-mile pace.

Rory McNamara, 16, of Litchfield placed second with a 22:16 clocking in the final regular race for 2022 - the 46th season of the series.

The runners will award plaques to the top six male and top six female runners in the 2022 standings on Saturday, December 3, at 8:30 a.m. before a fun run, which will start near the Everett B. Hurlburt Community Park at 18 Apple Lane.

Runners are encouraged to bring unwrapped toys to donate to needy children, as well as non-perishable goods for the Roxbury Food Pantry.

The 2023 series is tentatively scheduled to launch its 47th season with a fun run on Saturday, February 25, at 8:30 a.m. The first official race is slated for Saturday, March 4, at 8:30 a.m.

The races, which are sanctioned by the Roxbury Recreation Commission, start and finish near the Hurlburt Community Park.
